As a proud native of Nigeria, my country is a source, transit and destination country when it comes to human trafficking. Per the latest Global Slavery Index Report, Nigeria ranks 32/167 of the countries with the highest number of slaves – 1,386,000. Its National Agency for the Prohibition of Trafficking in Persons (NAPTIP) reports that the average age of trafficked children in Nigeria is 15. Solemnly, 75% of those who are trafficked within Nigeria are trafficked across states, while 23% are trafficked within states.

Unfortunately, these are not just statistics, they are children and it is the third most common crime in Nigeria after drug trafficking and economic fraud. Some of factors that increase vulnerability to trafficking in Nigeria include extreme poverty, corruption, conflict, climate change/resulting migration and western consumerism. This must change!
